Would you like to get to know the German Parliament?

The German Bundestag invites you to spend four weeks in Berlin in September.

The programme is intended for young people from Arab countries who are interested in politics and who are keen to play an active role in promoting core democratic values and a vibrant civil society in their home countries. The German Bundestag is offering you the opportunity to get to know the German parliamentary system during an intensive programme.

A one-week work placement with a Member of the German Bundestag allows you to experience day-to-day life in their office and to come into contact with political decision-makers.

Successful candidates will be chosen by the German Bundestag's independent selection panel.

The scholarship

Participants will receive a scholarship of 700 euros. In addition, accommodation in an apartment complex will be provided free of charge, and the costs of travel to and from Berlin will be covered, as well as the costs of health, accident and personal liability insurance.



Criteria

- Citizenship of an Arab country
- Under the age of 35 at the start of the scholarship
- University degree
- Good knowledge of German (Level B2)
- An interest in politics, and social/political commitment
